

These are responses from Eco Ambassadors during in-person workshop

- Posters wider reach to various schools
- Hand out notes to homes and schools
- Local Businesses reusable (non-single plastic items)
- Incentive programs (point system, stamps, free gift) @schools, businesses
 - Places where youth and children go / where plastic items are used
- Recycling programs in high schools
 - +Education on what is recyclable or not / proper recycling
- Community conversations & household conversations
